### Investment objective

Aims to provide long-term tax effective total returns, with diversification across a broad range of Australian companies and industries.

## Investment approach

The fund uses a systematic quantitative rules-based approach to build a diversified portfolio by considering factors such as the quality of a company, its growth potential and its implied value relative to its price. The approach considers the tax position of each holding and incorporates additional active investment insights to take advantage of dividends, associated franking credits and other tax effective payments with the aim of delivering an enhanced after-tax return.

### Performance commentary

For the one-month period ending 31 March 2022 the after fee and tax return was 5.82%.

Consumer Staples, Financials and Materials sectors were the largest contributors to active return during the month.

By contrast, allocation in Industrials, Communication Services and Healthcare were the largest detractors for the month.

At a stock level Champion Iron Ltd, Origin Energy Ltd and Reece Ltd were the top contributors. On the other side, positions in Sonic Healthcare Ltd, Charter Hall Group and BHP Group detracted from returns.

The rolling 12-month cash dividend yield of the fund is forecast to be 4.1% versus the S&P/ASX200 Index of 4.1%.

### Market commentary

The Australian equity market (S&P/ASX 200 Accumulation Index) returned 6.9% over the month of March 2022. Russia's invasion of Ukraine dominated news flow in the first quarter of 2022. This further stoked rising inflation as commodity prices rose on supply concerns for European energy supplies from Russia and soft commodity exports from Ukraine. These concerns caused the Energy, Mining and Utilities sectors to surge here in Australia ensuring that the local index remains higher on a year-to-date basis.

Sector wise, the best performer was Energy while Utilities and Materials sectors also performed well.


Information Technology was the worst performing sector, while Healthcare and Consumer Discretionary also fell in March.
