Performance commentary

For the one-month period ending 31 March 2025 the after fee and tax return was -2.39%.

Over March, telecommunications, information technology and energy outperformed other sectors, whilst healthcare and consumer discretionary underperformed. Stock specific effects, which are not attributable to any proprietary factor, had a positive effect over the month.

Market commentary

The Australian equity market (S&P/ASX 200 Accumulation Index) returned -3.39% over the month of March 2025.

Over March, all sectors fell except for utilities. In terms of return drivers, value closed the month positively, outperforming both momentum, which remained flat, and quality which detracted over the course of the month.

Investment objective

Aims to provide long-term tax effective total returns, with diversification across a broad range of Australian companies and industries.

Investment approach

The fund uses a systematic quantitative rules-based approach to build a diversified portfolio by considering factors such as the quality of a company, its growth potential and its implied value relative to its price. The approach considers the tax position of each holding and incorporates additional active investment insights to take advantage of dividends, associated franking credits and other tax effective payments with the aim of delivering an enhanced after-tax return.

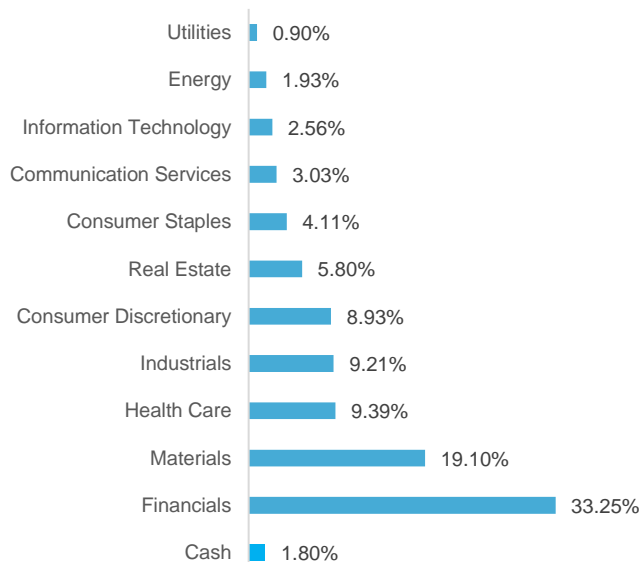
