### Investment objective

The fund aims to provide long-term tax effective total returns, which track the performance of the MSCI World Index (AUD) before fees and tax

## Investment approach

The fund uses a systematic quantitative rules-based approach to build a diversified portfolio by considering factors such as the quality of a company, its growth potential and its implied value relative to its price. The approach considers the tax position of each holding and incorporates additional active investment insights to take advantage of dividends, associated foreign tax credits and other tax effective payments with the aim of delivering an enhanced after-tax return.

### Performance commentary

For the one-month period ending 31 October 2025 the after fee and tax return was 2.72%.

### Market commentary

Global equities advanced in October with large caps outperforming their smaller peers.

US equity markets advanced, outperforming global peers. Investor sentiment was buoyed by continued strong Al demand, positive corporate earnings, and a Fed rate cut. It wasn't all smooth sailing as Fed Chair Jerome Powell signalled that December rate cut was "far from" a foregone conclusion, tempering market expectations.

In Europe, equities continued their upward march, setting new highs in the process as a good start to Q3 earnings, fading trade tensions and resilient economic data underpinned equity markets. Al tailwinds helped the technology sector to perform well, utilities benefited from the Al infrastructure demand and healthcare also outperformed on the back of lower FX headwinds and easing drug pricing concerns.


Elsewhere, Asia Pacific equities also advanced supported by stronger export data and tech-friendly policy signals. Technology strength lifted Taiwan and Korea, with Al demand and APEC (Asia-Pacific Economic Cooperation) summit optimism driving performance. Chinese equity markets declined, while Japanese equities rose supported by political stability and a strong rally in technology shares.
